- 3. When you enter the slide show, the control panel of audio (microphone) and video (camera) is located in the right lower corner. When they are on, click the record on the left upper corner to start your recording.
- 4. Click the forward or backward button to change your slide. You can also use space bar to go to next slide. Click stop or press escape to stop the recording.
- 5. Save the file with narration by using save as. Select the format of mp4.
